(ICAR Accredited college)

Duration of Course: **4 Years**

Eligibility:

U.G. Programme	Eligibility Criteria	
B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science: for both boys and girls (formerly B.Sc. (Hons) Home Science)	A pass in two-year Intermediate examination (10+2) with Bi.P.C / M.P.C / M.Bi.P.C subjects. Diploma in Home Science (3 years) / Diploma in Agriculture, Seed Technology, Organic Farming, Horticulture, Veterinary (2 years)/Diploma in Agricultural Engineering (3 years) of ANGRAU. Candidates passed in a three-year Diploma course in Home Science can also apply for admission into B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science course under 10% supernumerary seats i.e., 10 seats.	100

Criteria for selection:

- The candidates shall be selected based on merit in optional subjects of the two-year Intermediate Examination as per the rule of reservation. In case of other equivalent examinations passed by the candidates, the weightage of marks obtained in optional subjects shall be reckoned on par with those of the two-year Intermediate examination.
- In case of a tie in aggregate marks obtained by two or more candidates, the marks secured in the Intermediate (10+2) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidates shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference for the seat.

For admission into Un-Reserved quota seats of Andhra Pradesh, the candidates from the Telangana State will have to compete based on the marks obtained in the Board of Intermediate Education or its equivalent. (Subject to Government Orders).

Age:

- The candidates for admission to this course in the University shall be required to have completed 17 years of age on the 31st of December, 2025 of the year of admission with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates and 27 years for Physically Challenged (Differently Abled) candidates.

Reservation of seats for the candidates from Rural Areas:

- 40% of the seats in this course are reserved for candidates coming from rural areas. Candidates seeking admission under this category should produce a certificate(s) from the Heads of Institutions that the candidate has studied for a period of minimum 4 years in the schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from the 1st class to the 12th class / Intermediate (any four years). The relevant information has to be filled in the proforma as prescribed in **Form-I** of the application form duly signed by the Head of the Institution concerned.
- If the certificate referred to above has not filled in the proforma in application form duly signed by the concerned Head of Institution or Officer mentioned above along with office seal, the claim of the candidates under this category will be rejected.

Reservation of Seats:

Backward Classes : 29% of seats are reserved under this category
(BC-A – 7% ; BC-B – 10% ; BC-C – 1% ; BC-D – 7% ; BC-E – 4%)

- **Note:** The counselling/verification under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC, SG & Sports) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned and seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) – 10% (supernumerary seats)

Reservation of seats for Women: In each course, 33.3% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

Allocation of seats in favour of local candidates in relation to Local Area:

- 15 % seats shall be Un-Reserved (UR) for candidates from AU / SVU region. For the 85% local seats, the seats shall be allocated in 65.62 : 34.38 ratio in Andhra University and Sri Venkateswara University area, respectively among the candidates in relation to the local area.

Hostel Facility:

Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation.

Fee: The candidates who are granted admission shall pay the prescribed fee at the time of joining the college and hostel.

NOTE:

- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science for the Academic Year 2025-26, an amount of Rs. 4,860/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat after closure of admissions process for the AY 2025-26, the fees already paid will not be refunded and in addition, he/she has to pay an amount of Rs. 4,860/- towards Seat Cancellation fee for General (for SC/ST/PH - Rs. 2,430/-)
- Original certificates shall be produced at the time of Counseling.

The candidate who secures a seat, should submit the following certificates in Original at the time of joining the college.

- i) Two conduct certificates one from the College or School where the candidate last studied and the other from an officer of the State Government or any other respectable person.
 - ii) SSC or equivalent examination certificate
 - iii) Transfer Certificate from the College or School where the candidate last studied.
 - iv) Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination (Intermediate / 3 years Diploma in Home Science)
