Note: The admission into the remaining 60% seats of ANGRAU and 75% seats of SVVU is being taken up by the Convenor, AP EAPCET 2021 through Web based General Engineering Counseling. The candidates are requested to make Web options during General Engineering Counseling. Those who apply under Farmers Quota can also apply for general quota seats, if they desire.

Eligibility:

A pass in two year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, A.P. or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:

- i) Mathematics
- ii) Physical Sciences

Criteria for selection:

The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the AP EAPCET 2021. The candidates will be selected based on merit, presidential order, region and social status.

Age:

The candidates for admission to these courses shall be required to have completed 17 years of age on 31st December, 2021 of the year of admission with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates and 27 years for Physically Handicapped (Differently abled) candidates.

Reservations:**Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturist cum Rural Area (Farmers' Quota):**

- **The seats** are reserved for candidates coming from families of Agriculturists (Farmers) owning **not less than 1 acre of land either in the name of the parents or in the name of the candidates** and who have studied for a **minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas**. If the land is owned by **grandfather, grandmother or guardian or any other relations is not acceptable**.
- **FORM-I:** It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the **candidate / parents** duly certified by **the Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar with office seal**. **Candidate must also upload land owned record-Adangal / 1B from Meebhoomi Land records (or) Original Pattadar Passbook as evidence for the extent of land owned**.
- **Form-II:** It is a proforma to be certified by **the Head Master** of the School with office seal recently that the candidate has studied for a **minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (**Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate**).
- **Duly filled in Form-I and Form-II** with the **signatures of concerned officials viz., Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar and concerned Head of Institution, respectively**, along with office seal need to be uploaded. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.
During certificate verification under farmer's quota, the candidate must produce uploaded original Form I, Form II, the original pattadar passbook or 1B Adangal from Mee-seva as an evidence for the extent of land. Study certificates from the educational institutions studied as per application registered.

Reservation of Seats:

Backward Classes: 29% of seats are reserved under this category.

(BC-A – 7%; BC-B – 10%; BC-C – 1%; BC-D – 7%, BC-E – 4%)

Scheduled Caste (SC) – 15%

Scheduled Tribe (ST) – 6%

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) – 10% (supernumerary seats)

Reservation of seats for Women: In each course, 33⅓ % of the seats shall be reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

Allocation of seats in favour of Local candidates in relation to Local area:

- Out of total intake, 15% of seats shall be Un- reserved (UR) for candidate from AU/SVU region. Candidates from Osmania University (OU) region (Telangana State), also can compete for these seats with AP EAPCET 2021 ranks.
- For the 85% of local seats, the seats shall be allocated in 42: 22 ratio in Andhra University and Sri Venkateswara University, respectively among the candidates in relation to local area.

Local status certificate:

Candidate claiming local status in Andhra Pradesh (AU/SVU) by virtue of his/her migration from the State of Telangana shall submit scanned copy of Local status certificate issued in Form-III by Tahsildar of concerned along with their application (**as per G.O.Ms.No.171, General Administration (SPF & MC) Department dated 20-11-2017**).

Allotment of seats during online counseling process:

The candidates are required to **attend Certificate Verification** on the dates indicated (**19-10-2021, 21-10-2021 & 22-10-2021**) at any verification centre convenient for them (**Verification Centre: Attached separately**). Subsequently, the candidate are **required to exercise web-options on the dates notified** for desired courses / colleges.

Based on Merit in AP EAPCET 2021 duly following Presidential Order & Rule of reservation and based on the web-options given by the candidate, the seat allotment will be done.

The candidate needs to exercise online self-admission into the allotted college, report at allotted college with all original certificates and pay fee in the stipulated time. Failing which the seat falls vacant, which will be filled in next phase of online-counseling.

Fee: The particulars of fees for first semester are given hereunder for ready reference. The candidates who are granted admission shall pay the prescribed fee at the time of joining the college and hostel.

NOTE:

- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for the Academic Year 2021-22 an amount of Rs. 1,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat after closure of admissions process for the AY 2021-22 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid and in addition, he/she has to pay an amount of Rs. 1,000/- towards processing fee.

Original certificates to be produced & submitted at the time of joining the college:

The candidates granted admission, should at the time of admission submit the following certificates **in Original.**

- Pass Certificate-cum-Memorandum of Marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination (Intermediate) or its equivalent.
- Hall Ticket & Rank Card of AP EAPCET 2021.
- SSC or equivalent examination Certificate.
- The Community Certificate in the case of candidates belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, signed by the competent authority.
- Bonafide or Study certificates. (VI to XII)
- Residence Certificate, if necessary.
- Transfer Certificate from the College or School where the candidate last studied.
- Form I and Form II with evidence of land owned- Adangal / 1B (or) Copy of Original Pattadar Passbook.

Age Limit - Eligibility Criteria:

For General Category Candidates:

17 years of age on 31st December 2021 – Upper age limit 22 years.

Candidates should not born after 31st December 2004 and should not born before 31st December 1999

For ST & ST Candidates: Upper Age limit 25 years

Candidates should not born after 31st December 2004 and should not born before 31st December 1996

Physically Challenged (PH) candidates: Upper age limit 27 years

Candidates should not born after 31st December 2004 and should not born before 31st December 1994

Grievance Request:

- The Data/Information of all candidates has been considered from EAPCET 2021 examination as entered by the candidates and validated for EAPCET examination.
- If any candidate wants to edit or upload any document now in support of candidature, the candidate first must COMPLETE REGISTRATION process.
- A registered candidate can edit or upload any certificate/ document by Applying from "Grievance Request" and add/upload documents or Certificates in relevant fields, THIS FACILITY can be AVAILED ONLY ONCE. All those uploaded documents will be considered for further processing only subject to the verification by the competent authorities.

Login:

No separate login is required for the candidates as the **Registered Mobile number** and **Hall Ticket** would be authenticated for all services such as Registration, Grievance requests, Web Options, print payment receipt, etc.
