### Admission into B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science without EAPCET in Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University for the academic year 2021-22

**B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science (Four years)** : College of Community Science, Lam, Guntur

#### Total intake and eligibility:

U.G. Programme	Total intake	Eligibility Criteria
B.Sc.(Hons) Community Science: for both boys and girls (formerly B.Sc. (Hons) Home Science)	83	A pass in two year Intermediate examination (10+2) with Bi.P.C / M.P.C / M.Bi.P.C subjects. Candidates passed in a <b>three year Diploma course in Home Science</b> can also apply for admission into B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science course under 10% supernumerary seats

#### Criteria for selection:

- The candidates shall be selected based on merit in optional subjects of the two year Intermediate Examination as per the rule of reservation. In case of other equivalent examinations passed by the candidates, the weightage of marks obtained in optional subjects shall be reckoned on par with those of the two year Intermediate examination.
- In case of a tie in aggregate marks obtained by two or more candidates, the marks secured in the Intermediate (10+2) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidates shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference for the seat.

**For admission into Un-Reserved quota seats of Andhra Pradesh, the candidates from the Telangana State will have to compete based on the marks obtained in the Board of Intermediate Education or its equivalent.**

#### Age:

- The candidates for admission to this course in the University shall be required to have completed 17 years of age on the 31<sup>st</sup> of December, 2021 of the year of admission with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates and 27 years for Physically Challenged (Differently Abled) candidates.

#### Reservation of seats for the candidates from Rural Areas:

- 40% of the seats in this course are reserved for candidates coming from rural areas. Candidates seeking admission under this category should produce a certificate(s) from the Heads of Institutions that the candidate has studied for a period of minimum 4 years in the schools located in Non-Municipal areas during their period of study from the 1<sup>st</sup> class to the 12<sup>th</sup> class / Intermediate (any four years). The relevant information has to be filled in the proforma as prescribed in **Form-I** of the application form duly signed by the Head of the Institution concerned.
- If the certificate referred to above has not filled in the proforma in application form duly signed by the concerned Head of Institution or Officer mentioned above along with office seal, the claim of the candidates under this category will be rejected.

#### Reservation of Seats:

**Backward Classes: 29%** of seats are reserved under this category.

- BC-A – 7% ; BC-B – 10% ; BC-C – 1% ; BC-D – 7% ; BC-E – 4%

**Economically Weaker Section (EWS) – 10% (supernumerary seats)**

**Reservation of seats for Women:** In each course, 33 1/3% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

**Allocation of seats in favour of local candidates in relation to Local Area:**

- Out of total intake, 15% of seats shall be Un- reserved (UR). For these seats any candidate from AU/SVU region can compete with intermediate marks of A.P. Candidates from Osmania University (OU) region (Telangana State), also are eligible to compete for these seats with intermediate marks of Telangana State.
- Admission to 85% of the seats, the seats shall be allocated with 42: 22 ratio in Andhra University and Sri Venkateswara University, respectively among the candidates in relation to local area.
- Candidate claiming local status in Andhra Pradesh (AU/SVU) by virtue of his/her migration from the State of Telangana shall submit scanned copy of Local status certificate issued in Form-III by Tahsildar of concerned along with their application (as per G.O.Ms.No.171, General Administration (SPF & MC) Department dated 20-11-2017)

**Hostel facility:**

**Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation.**

The candidates who are granted admission shall pay the prescribed fee at the time of joining the college and hostel.

  - vii) An Income Certificate of father / mother signed by any Officer not below the rank of the Mandal Revenue Officer of the Revenue Department of the Mandal concerned.
