- The admission into the remaining 60% seats (Non-Farmer MPC Stream) of ANGRAU will be taken up by the Convenor, AP EAPCET 2026 through Web based General Engineering Counselling conducted by APSICHE.
- Those who apply under Farmers' Quota can also apply for general quota seats, if they desire.

Eligibility:

B.Tech. (Agricultural Engineering) & B.Tech. (Food Technology) under MPC Stream

A pass in two-year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, A.P. or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:

- i) Mathematics
- ii) Physical Sciences

Criteria for selection: The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the AP EAPCET 2026. The candidates will be selected based on merit, presidential order, region and social status.

Age Limit - Eligibility Criteria as on 31st December 2026

For General Category: Minimum age limit is 17 years – Upper age limit 22 years
(Candidates should be born between 01st January 2005 – 31 December 2009)

For SC & ST Candidates: Minimum age limit is 17 years – Upper Age limit 25 years
(Candidates should be born between 01st January 2002 – 31 December 2009)

Physically Challenged candidates: Minimum age limit is 17 years – Upper Age limit 27 years
(Candidates should be born between 01st January 2000 – 31 December 2009)

Farmers' Quota (Forty per cent (40%) of the seats):

- Reservation (Forty per cent (40%) of the seats in the ANGRAU) for the candidates coming from families of Agriculturist *cum* Rural Area:
 - ✓ **Candidates with not less than 1 (one) acre of land is eligible.**
 - ✓ **Land should be in the name of the parents or in the name of the candidates**
(If the land is owned by grandfather, grandmother or guardian or any other relations is not acceptable)
 - ✓ **Candidate should have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.**
- If the candidates applied under farmers quota they have to produce the following forms:

Form - I

- It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the **candidate / parents** duly certified by **the Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar** with office seal.

Form - II

- It is a proforma to be certified by **the Head Master** of the School **with office seal** recently that the candidate has studied for a **minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate.
- Certificates to be enclosed to claim farmers quota

1	Duly filled Form-I with the signature of Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar
2	Duly filled Form-II with the signature of Head of Institution
3	Adangal /1B from Meebhoomi as evidence for the extent of land

If the candidate not enclosed the above four documents, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily **rejected**.

Reservation of Seats:

Backward Classes	:	29% of seats are reserved under this category (BC-A – 7%; BC-B – 10% BC-C – 1%; BC-D – 7%; BC-E – 4%)

Note: The counselling/verification under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC, SG & Sports) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned and seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) – 10% (supernumerary seats)

Reservation of seats for Women: 33⅓ % of the seats shall be reserved in favor of women candidates from each category.

Allocation of seats in favour of Local candidates in relation to Local area:

- Admissions to 85% of available seats shall be reserved in favour of local candidates of Andhra University and Sri Venkateswara University regions in the ratio of 65.62 and 34.38 respectively. The rest of 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved for candidates of local / nonlocal areas to be filled as per the item (ii) (C) under G.O.Ms.No.21 Higher Education (EC) Department, Dt.12-05-2025.

Allotment of seats during counselling process: The allotment of seats will be done during manual counselling. The dates and venue for the counselling will be notified later in website. **The candidates who submit application form with all enclosures including the fee paid will be called for counselling for allotment of seats based on merit.**

Fee: The candidates who have secured admission shall pay the prescribed fee at the time of joining the college and hostel.

NOTE:

- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat **before the closure of admissions** for the Academic Year 2026-27, an amount of **Rs. 5,350/-** shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat **after closure of admissions** process for the AY 2026-27, the candidate forfeits the fees already paid (*except refundable deposits*) and in addition, he/she has to pay an amount of **Rs. 5,350/-** towards Seat Cancellation fee for General and for SC/ST/PH - **Rs.2,670/-**.
