From the Vice-Chancellor's Desk

ANGRAU is celebrating its Diamond Jubilee year (1963-2023), a landmark year for a State Agricultural University (SAU) in India and a jubilant moment for the state of Andhra Pradesh and its farmers. On teaching front, a new Agriculture College was inaugurated at Pulivendula, Y.S.R. Kadapa district by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Sri Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, who hails from the Y.S.R. Kadapa district. With the establishment of this new agricultural college in the resource-poor region, ANGRAU pledged itself to build more

human resources in agriculture and re-dedicate itself in the service of the farmers. As a part of diamond jubilee celebrations, various academic events are organized by the centres of ANGRAU.

Furthermore, 111th Academic Council Meeting was held and it is decided that National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 guidelines will be adopted by ANGRAU and followed. Inter-Collegiate Sports and Cultural Meet was held for the students for the year 2023 in three phases in the month of November. College of Community Science, Guntur is celebrating a decade of its establishment (2013- 2023) and organized various lectures to commemorate its accomplishments. Open and Distance Learning Centre (ODLC), Guntur started few courses in this quarter and enrolled rural youth, farmers and farm women, etc.
